Notes:

1) Students can freely apply for each of the programs; however, the Confucius Institutes who hosting the summer camp registration have their right to request the candidates registering for 12 weeks Chinese language or Kongfu study starting from March 1st, 2019. Enrollments of 2019 CI Summer Camp will be finished by **February 20th, 2019**; and the acceptance letters will be issued by the end of February, 2019.

2) Programs during July 14th – 27th 2019 are covered by CI scholarship; students need pay for their international air tickets, visa applications, food and pocket money; After the enrollment, each participant needs pay 220 Euro program fee to an agency's bank account as a guarantee fee for her/his participating, which is refundable in Chinese *Yuan* (RMB) after her/his arrival in Beijing; Invoices will be sent to participants by **May 10th, 2019**. Payments transferring needs to be finished by **May 20th, 2019** since the tickets booking for participants will began at the beginning of June. Costs of bank services will be borne by participants themselves.

3) The expense for the additional 3rd week is 700 Euro per person. Participants need also transfer the money to the agency after receiving the invoices. Timing request is same as the guarantee fees.

4) 2019 CI summer camp will not organize group meals for students; the organizers will guide participants to find their daily food along with the trip. If the high school students group will need a group meal service, which can be discussed individually with the agency.

5) The deadline of free cancellation is **June 10th 2019**. After the deadline, the payment of guarantee (220 Euro) is not refundable. The deadline of free cancellation for the additional 3rd week is **June 20th 2019**. After this date, the program fee (700 Euro) is not refundable too.
