Arrival

Work in international teams


Company visit:

Risk Management Simulation Game Doclogistics

Students are tasked with risk management for Doclogistics, a company that handles shipping for other companies. To complete their risk management task they have to use several steps of the risk management process. Their goal is to make efficient use of risk management resources. The resources they can use are the combined costs of control measures they purchase and the impact of risks that still do occur. Efficient use of these resources means these combined costs are kept low.
